



Packing plates

For the professional packing of plates and similar objects, we offer a special plate paper that is to be put between the individual plates/objects. This makes packing comparably easy. Always start with the big plates and proceed to the small ones.

Put a plate sheet on the big sheet of white paper, put the first plate on it and put another plate sheet on the plate. Now put the second plate on it. Repeat this step until you got a package of four or five plates. The final layer is a plate sheet again.

Now, wrap this stack two times, put the lateral parts on it and wrap further until you reach the end of the big sheet. Also in this case, you may repeat the wrapping process. When putting the wrapped stack of plates into the removal box, make sure to put it on end. Position the individual stacks along the box's width only, not in longitudinal direction. Put the next stacks next to the first one, and when the box already seems to be full, put another package between the others. To do so, slide the stacks a bit apart from each other in the middle and carefully push the last stack into the box. Now, you can see that the airbag principle works as the stacks can still slightly move, but are stable enough to avoid damages.

When you have put several rows into the box, there is still some useful space left. Use this space to put some lighter items onto the plate packages to avoid that the box becomes too heavy. Light glasses, cups or also cushions or table linen would be perfect.
